



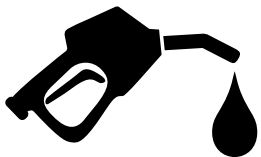

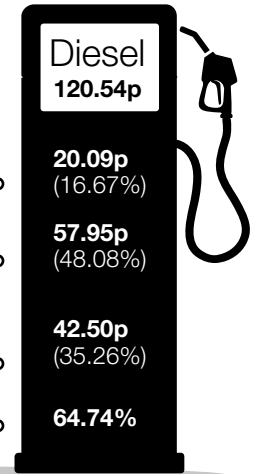

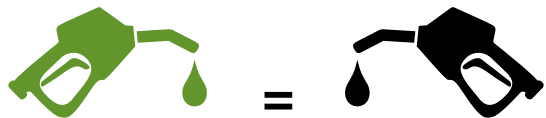

UK Fuel Duty

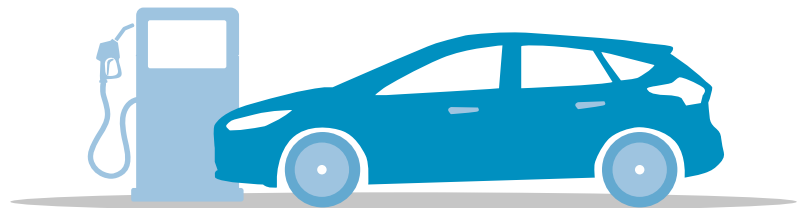


Fuel duty is **57.95p** a litre

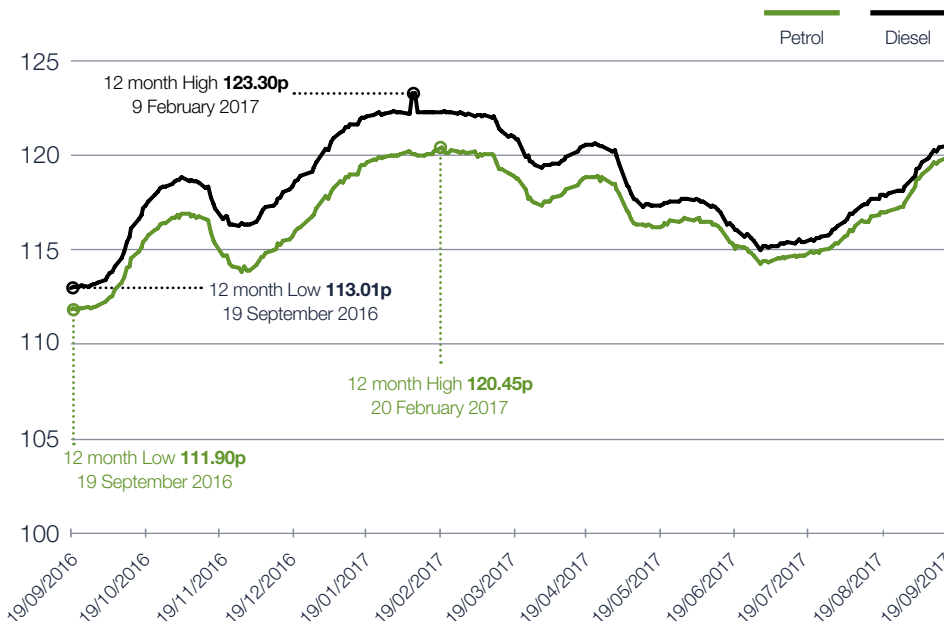
Cost to fill up an average car at the pumps in the UK*

UK vs EU Pre-Tax

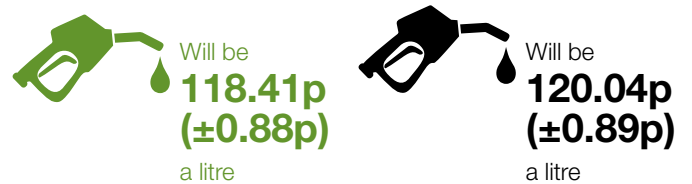
Pre-tax in the EU, the UK has the **22nd** most expensive petrol and the **21st** most expensive diesel

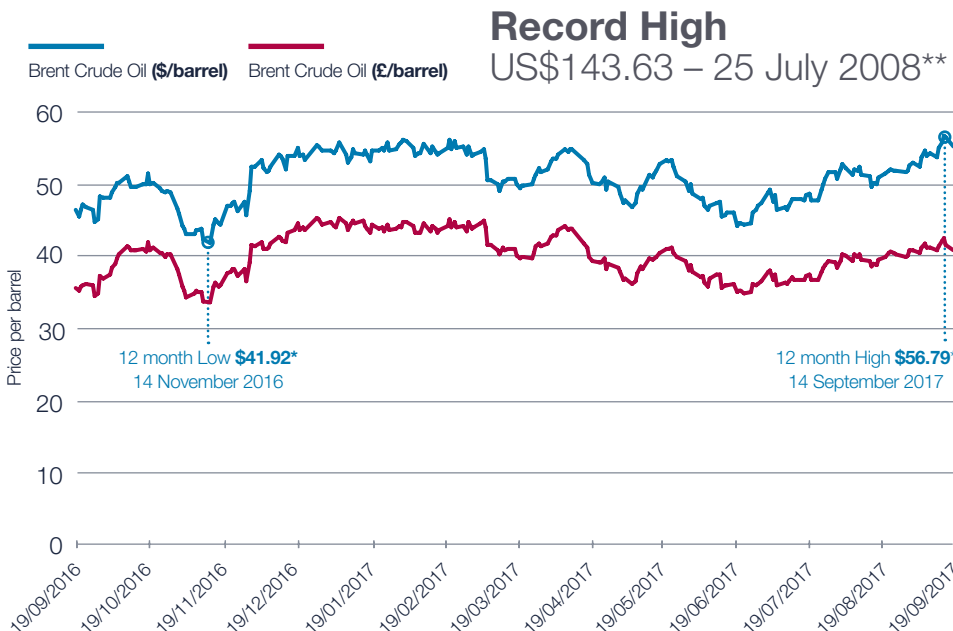


Fuel price prediction

Based on **18 September 2017** average pump prices, analysis of historical fuel data suggests, with 95% confidence, that for the week commencing **2 October 2017**



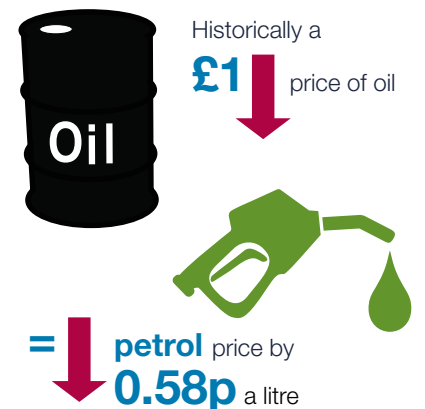
Oil price over the last 12 months
