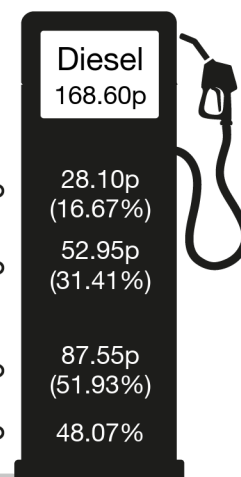
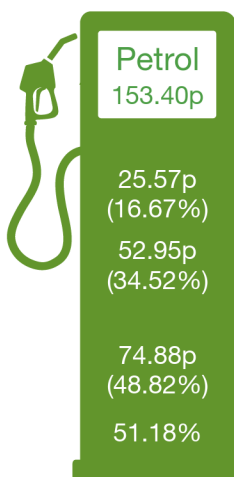

since March 2011.

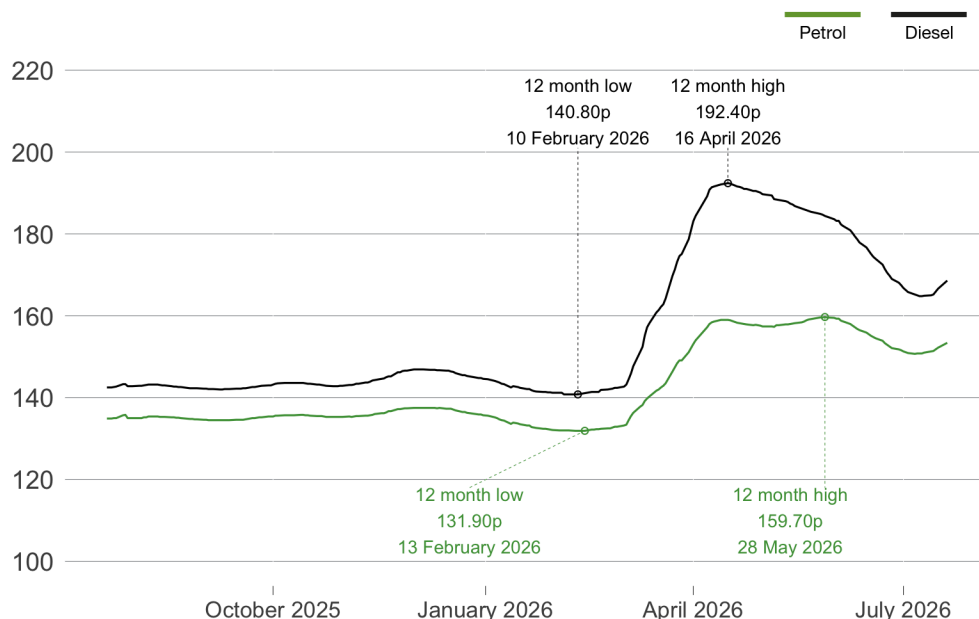
Cost to fill up an average car at the pumps in the UK*

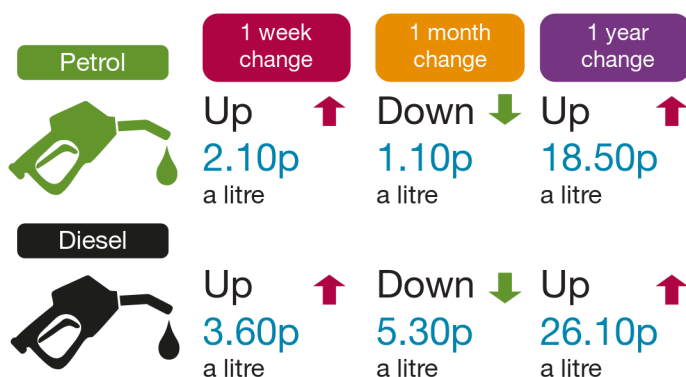

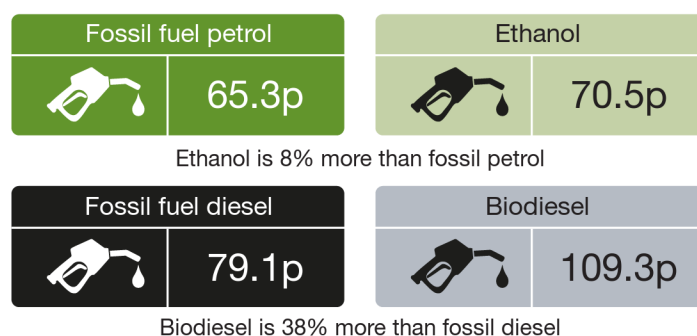
