Speeding offence detection and disposal in England and Wales, 2018-19

A Report for the RAC Foundation by Dr Adam Snow and Doreen Lam

This report provides an annual update on statistics on speeding offences detected by police forces in England and Wales. It is based on analysis of Home Office data.¹

As in previous versions of the report there is a great deal of variation between constabularies. In 2018-19, some 2,386,780 speeding offences were detected in England and Wales, a 4.1% (94,246) increase on the previous 12 months. Over the last five years the number of those caught speeding has increased by 15.5%.

Looking at the figures for individual police forces perhaps the biggest change has been seen in Avon and Somerset which no longer leads the way in the number of fixed penalty notices (FPNs) issued. The top five are now: West Yorkshire Police, Avon and Somerset, the Metropolitan Police (including City of London), Thames Valley and Greater Manchester.

As highlighted in previous reports the differences between forces are likely be down to a multitude of factors:

"The constabulary-level variations in detection rates is significant but difficult to understand from the bald numbers. However, reasons for the differences are likely to include: road network length, road type, traffic volume and makeup, local priorities dictated by police and crime commissioners, financial and human resources, and the availability of detection technology."

As Table 2 shows, the annual number of FPNs issued and awareness courses attended increased again by a small percentage, echoing increases in previous years.

In 2018, there were 1,782 fatalities on Great Britain's roads, a total that has barely changed since 2012.² According to the Department for Transport:

"The evidence points towards Britain being in a period when the fatality numbers are stable and most of the changes relate to random variation."

In 2018, "exceeding the speed limit" was recorded as a contributory factor in 13% of fatal crashes where at least one factor was identified. "Travelling too fast for the conditions" was a contributory factor in 9% of fatal crashes. More than one contributory factor might be recorded per incident.
